Permit me to introduce myself, I am Water and Wasterwater Utilities Counsel to Marion County, Florida. The County forwarded to me your communication to Gordon Johnston, the Marion County Attorney, regarding Silver City's utility. There seems to be some confusion as to whether or not Silver City Utilities is in fact a "utility." While the enclosed letter from David Small lists a number in the RE of the letter ("WU362"), the letter goes on to state that "We again reiterate that the Utility has never received any revenue from its customers at any time and also has never had a rate case done." There is some reference in a 1999 letter to having a certificate, but again based on the description in the letter, it does not appear that Silver City is in fact a "utility." If not, that means that they are not entitled to take advantage of the abandonment statute under Section 367.165, Florida Statutes. This is because the statute only applies to "utilities."

At this time, the Board of County Commissioners has no intention of taking over this water system. I will call you today to see if we can get to the bottom of this mess.
