F) Docket No. 011377-EI - Application of Florida Power Corporation (FPC or Company) for approval pursuant to Chapter 25-8, Florida Administrative Code, and Section 366.04, Florida Statutes, for authority to issue, sell or otherwise incur during 2002, any combination of additional equity securities and long-term debt securities and obligations, consisting of up to \$400 million outstanding at any time of commercial paper backed by, or borrowed under, the Company's long-term credit agreements, and \$1.24 billion of any combination of equity securities and other long-term debt securities and obligations. FPC also proposes to issue, sell and have outstanding at any given time during 2002 short-term unsecured securities and debt obligations, including commercial paper classified as short-term debt for accounting purposes, in an aggregate amount not in excess of \$500 million.

For monitoring purposes, this docket must remain open until April 15, 2003, to allow the Company time to file the required Consummation Report.

G) DOCKET NO. 011398-GU - Application by Florida Public Utilities Company (FPUC) for authority to issue and sell and/or exchange any combination of long-term debt, short-term notes and equity securities and/or to assume liabilities or obligations as guarantor, endorser or surety in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$75 million during the calendar year 2002.

For monitoring purposes, this docket must remain open until April 15, 2003, to allow the Company time to file the required Consummation Report.
