We have been developing residential communities in United Water Florida's ("UWF") service area for more than 10 years and have connected over 500 residential customers to their system during that time. Our customers have generally been first time buyers who are very sensitive to price increases.

The proposed increase in UWF's plant capacity charges will cause the price of a single family home to increase by more than \$2,000 in their service area. This will result in many first time buyers no longer being able to purchase a new home in their service area.

Our concerns are two fold. First, the plant capacity charges should be increased gradually (Suggestion – Increase the charges by ½ of the total proposed increase for the first 2 years after approval and then increase to the proposed level). Second, the increase should not apply to developments with Utility Agreements in place as of the date of approval (since in most cases the developer has invested significant sums of money in reliance on the current tariff of United Water).

Having been the President of a water and sewer utility, I understand the relationship between rate base and customer rates, and your charge to protect the consumer. I also have observed the impact of a 3X+ increase in capacity charges on a utility like Florida Water, where new development has virtually ceased since the increase. Without new development in their Northeast Florida service areas, if they haven't already, they will soon have to face up to significant deferred maintenance costs which will fall upon the consumer since they have no income from capacity charges to fund these costs.


