Dear Mr. Urane:

Ms. Toni McCoy forwarded your recent memo to me for handling since the above docket is pending. You requested cancellation of your ALEC certificate "effective the same date it was issued" due to nonuse. Unfortunately, staff cannot recommend that an effective date of a cancellation be made retroactive.

At the February 6, 2001 Agenda Conference, the Commissioners voted to impose a \$500 fine or cancel your ALEC certificate for nonpayment of the 1999 Regulatory Assessment Fee (RAF). In addition, the 2000 RAF is now past due.

Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code, provides that if a certificate is active for any day during a calendar year (whether that company ever conducted business or not), then the certificate holder is responsible for the RAF for that year. This means that in addition to the 1999 and 2000 RAFs, you are also responsible for the 2001 RAF.

Since you indicated you wanted to cancel your certificate, you need to pay all past due charges in full, plus either pay the 2001 fee or provide a date certain it would be paid. This will prevent the unpaid fees, including statutory penalty and interest charges, from being forwarded to the Comptroller's Office for further collection efforts. The 1999, 2000, and 2001 RAF returns are enclosed.

As information, the Commission uses the postmark date as the paid date. Therefore, if your payment is postmarked by March 1, 2001, you will owe \$69.50 for the 1999 fee (\$50.00 RAF, \$12.50 penalty, and \$7.00 interest), \$53.00 for the 2000 fee (\$50.00 RAF, \$2.50 penalty, and \$0.50 MENT NO: interest), and \$50.00 for the 2001 fee, for a grand total of \$172.50. Since the penalty and interest charges continue to accrue until paid, it is to your benefit to pay as soon as possible.

PART II HEARINGS INVOLVING DISPUTED ISSUES OF MATERIAL FACT

28-106.201 Initiation of Proceedings.

(1) Unless otherwise provided by statute, initiation of proceedings shall be made by written petition to the agency responsible for rendering final agency action. The term "petition" includes any document that requests an evidentiary proceeding and asserts the existence of a disputed issue of material fact. Each petition shall be legible and on 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ by 11 inch white paper. Unless printed, the impression shall be on one side of the paper only and lines shall be double-spaced.

(2) All petitions filed under these rules shall contain:

(a) The name and address of each agency affected and each agency's file or identification number, if known;

(b) The name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner; the name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any, which shall be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding; and an explanation of how the petitioner's substantial interests will be affected by the agency determination;

(c) A statement of when and how the petitioner received notice of the agency decision;

(d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petition must so indicate;

(e) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, including the specific facts the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action;

(f) A statement of the specific rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action; and

(g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action.

(3) Upon receipt of a petition involving disputed issues of material fact, the agency shall grant or deny the petition, and if granted shall, unless otherwise provided by law, refer the matter to the Division of Administrative Hearings with a request that an administrative law judge be assigned to conduct the hearing. The request shall be accompanied by a copy of the petition and a copy of the notice of agency action.

(4) A petition shall be dismissed if it is not in substantial compliance with subsection (2) of this rule or it has been untimely filed. Dismissal of a petition shall, at least once, be without prejudice to petitioner's filing a timely amended petition curing the defect, unless it conclusively appears from the face of the petition that the defect cannot be cured.

(5) The agency shall promptly give written notice to all parties of the action taken on the petition, shall state with particularity its reasons if the petition is not granted, and shall state the deadline for filing an amended petition if applicable.

25-24.820 Revocation of a Certificate.

(1) The Commission may on its own motion, after notice and opportunity for hearing, revoke a company's certificate for any of the following reasons:

(a) Violation of a term or condition under which the authority was originally granted;

(b) Violation of Commission rule or order;

(c) Violation of Florida Statute; or

(d) Violation of a price list standard.

(2) If a certificated company desires to cancel its certificate, it shall request cancellation from the Commission in writing and shall provide the following with its request. Cancellation of a certificate shall be ordered subject to the holder providing the required information.

(a) A statement of intent and date certain to pay regulatory assessment fee.

(b) A statement of why the certificate is proposed to be canceled.

(c) A statement as to how customer deposits and final bills will be handled.

(d) Proof of individual customer notice regarding discontinuance of service.

Dear Mr. Urane:

Ms. Toni McCoy forwarded your recent memo to me for handling since the above docket is pending. You requested cancellation of your ALEC certificate "effective the same date it was issued" due to nonuse. Unfortunately, staff cannot recommend that an effective date of a cancellation be made retroactive.

At the February 6, 2001 Agenda Conference, the Commissioners voted to impose a \$500 fine or cancel your ALEC certificate for nonpayment of the 1999 Regulatory Assessment Fee (RAF). In addition, the 2000 RAF is now past due.

Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code, provides that if a certificate is active for any day during a calendar year (whether that company ever conducted business or not), then the certificate holder is responsible for the RAF for that year. This means that in addition to the 1999 and 2000 RAFs, you are also responsible for the 2001 RAF.

Since you indicated you wanted to cancel your certificate, you need to pay all past due charges in full, plus either pay the 2001 fee or provide a date certain it would be paid. This will prevent the unpaid fees, including statutory penalty and interest charges, from being forwarded to the Comptroller's Office for further collection efforts. The 1999, 2000, and 2001 RAF returns are enclosed.

As information, the Commission uses the postmark date as the paid date. Therefore, if your payment is postmarked by March 1, 2001, you will owe \$69.50 for the 1999 fee (\$50.00 RAF, \$12.50 penalty, and \$7.00 interest), \$53.00 for the 2000 fee (\$50.00 RAF, \$2.50 penalty, and \$0.50 interest), and \$50.00 for the 2001 fee, for a grand total of \$172.50. Since the penalty and interest charges continue to accrue until paid, it is to your benefit to pay as soon as possible.
