A Few Of Our Homeowners Opinions About:

Gray Water

Hi, just a comment to this aloha problem. Maybe we should gather water samples. My water has been gray since we moved in 2 years ago. They had a water main break across the street and I had black water for days. We do not drink the water here at all. I buy drinking water and cooking water for fear of its color and taste. The water pressure is so bad that I can not even use my new shower massage as it is a trickle sometimes. What is with this Aloha system? I would be glad to send an email with my complaint also.

Dark Water

Please add my husband and my name to your list to ALOHA. We rarely use our large tub due to the dark water. We have to let the water run for a long time and at times it starts coming out black in the middle of filling the tub anyway.

Double Bill?

This first person here who said his bill was \$177 better check to make sure it is not for 2 months. Aloha sent me a bill for well over \$100, but never bothered to credit my previous payment. I think they were in the process of moving their offices and screwed up with previous payments. I personally know of 2 other people here in Trinity with the same complaint. I refuse to give them even one penny more than I have to.

Aloha Charges

Regarding the 2-months charge from Aloha, I've called them and was told that they had moved offices to 6915 Perrine Ranch Road, NPR 34655. New Phone # is 372-0115. If payment is not mailed to the new address, the next bill will probably show 2-months again, because it will take the Post Office up to 7 working days or more to forward mail to a new address (as we all have experienced in the past.

The Old Copper Pipe Story

Please add our name to the Aloha Water complaints. We have had Aloha out here a number of times and hear the same story when we have black water coming into our bath tubs. I don't understand why my parents had copper plumbing for years and their water was excellent.

An Amazing Story

If any of you have ever read the book or seen the movie, "Civil Action,"

I spent the first twelve years of my life living right in the middle of the whole toxic waste site and drinking the water from the poisonous wells. We were unaware of the problem when we moved out, and although there were many people all around us diagnosed with and dying of cancer, the connection was not immediately made. Thirty years have gone by and many other illnesses have surfaced that affect just too many people to be a coincidence. Many of us have kept in touch with different families from that area and there were many more deaths from cancer than those portrayed in the book. The clean up took over thirty years and we will probably never know the whole story and if any contaminated sites remain. The Aloha water problem frightens me. The Woburn (Mass) water didn't even taste or look bad. I cannot understand why the EPA cannot take action and intercede on behalf of all residents. It sickens me.

Pro and Con

You are getting a lot of opinions in response to your E-mails. That is wonderful. I hope all of the people expressing opinions are also writing to the PSC asking for help on the "Aloha Issue".

Response to AAAAH, Aloha

Only a few people write letters to the PSC. The PSC accordingly thinks it is just a few of us complainers who do write about ALOHA and often. This community is asleep and ALOHA wins. Even the Homeowners Association of Trinity Oaks was not present to represent us at the last PSC meeting.

I send the PSC a letter every week and they do not respond because I am almost the only one in the community complaining. Let's wake-up and start writing letters to the PSC if we really believe have a problem. Mike Fasano is the only political help we have and that is because he is affected by the bad water, but he can not do it alone. Our County Commissioners are not affected and accordingly refuse to get involved. Ann Hildebrand is affected by Lindrick and wants the county to purchase her utility but can care less about Aloha and our problem. Mike needs our letters to the PSC and our complaints sent directly to Aloha. I have been so vocal, I am now afraid they will cut my dirty water off completely. Let's post the letters the community is sending to the PSC and to Aloha on our community website as examples for the rest of the community. Come on Trinity, wake-up, stop complaining to your neighbors and start writing!

Increase For Poor Service

I come up with an approx. 45% increase in the sewer rates. Is this correct or am I missing something. Also I plan to write the PSC with a copy to our state rep. in Tallahassee if someone will tell me his name and address (I'm new to the area, you know). I will try to find him on the web.

?????????

Here is a question. What if water samples were taken from a number of our homes and tested. What if the testing source was licensed? If the water was shown to be poor, could we than take that to the appropriate county governing board or to a law firm and used as the basis for a class action suit against Aloha and/or the county?

Can such a large number of communities be complaining about nothing? These folks are more slippery than some politicians!
- 3. We plan to email your website to others, as you need more names for these documents. All Trinity Communities should support your efforts.

Displeased

Also, please add my wife, & myself as co-signers of the letter, we are Foxwood residents also totally displeased with Aloha Utilities.

I appreciate all of your efforts to bring our community together.

All Filtered Out

I sent a message about the lack of water pressure and that we had to put extensive water filters on the house, even the ice cube maker.

43 Members Strong

I am the vice-president of the Spyglass Homeowners Association and the water quality of Aloha Utilities is a constant topic of discussion with the Board and the homeowners. I would like you to include the name of our Association in your letter to the PSC. The Association represents the 43 homeowners in the Spyglass enclave.




