

NOTICE OF HEARING

TO WEDGEFIELD UTILITIES, INC. OFFICE OF PUBLIC COUNSEL AND ALL OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS

RE: DOCKET NO. 991437-WU APPLICATION FOR INCREASE IN WATER RATES IN ORANGE COUNTY BY WEDGEFIELD UTILITIES, INC. ISSUED: January 10, 2002

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a hearing will be held before the Florida Public Service Commission regarding the application of Wedgefield Utilities, Inc. for increase in water rates in Orange County, at the following time and place:

10:00 a.m., Monday, January 28, 2002, Wedgefield Golf Club, 20550 Maxim Parkway, Orlando, Florida 32827. Tuesday, January 29, 2002, has also been reserved for continuation of the hearing if needed. The starting time of the next day's session will be announced at the conclusion of the prior day. The hearing may be adjourned early if all testimony is concluded.

Customers will be given the opportunity to present testimony at the beginning of the morning session on Monday, January 28, 2002. Additionally, an evening session will be held beginning at 6:00 P.M., Monday, January 28, 2002 for the purpose of hearing testimony from customers who were unable to attend the prior session.

All customers wishing to testify are urged to be present at the beginning of the sessions, since the sessions may be adjourned early if no customers are present. By providing customer testimony, a person does not become a party to the proceeding, nor become an official party of record, nor must file a petition for intervention at least five days before the final hearing pursuant to the requirements contained in Rule 22.039, Florida Administrative Code.

PURPOSE AND PROCEDURE

The purpose of this hearing is to consider the petition of Wedgefield Utilities, Inc. for increase in water rates in Orange County and any motions or other matters that may be pending at the time of the hearing. The Commission may rule on any such motions from the bench or may take the matters under advisement.

At the hearing, all parties shall be given the opportunity to present testimony and other evidence on the issues identified by the parties at the pre-hearing conference held on July 9, 2001. All witnesses shall be subject to cross-examination at the conclusion of their testimony.

Any person requiring some accommodation at this hearing, because of a physical impairment should call the Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services at (850) 413-6370 at least 48 hours prior to the hearing. JURISDICTION

This Commission is vested with jurisdiction over the subject matter by the provisions of Chapter 367, Florida Statutes. This hearing will be governed by said Chapter as well as Chapter 120, Florida Statutes, and Chapters 25-26, 25-36, and 25-106, Florida Administrative Code.

APPLICABLE STATUTES AND RULES

Sections 367.001, 367.010, 367.101, Florida Statutes, and any other relevant sections of Chapter 367, Florida Statutes, are applicable to this proceeding, as well as Chapter 120, Florida Statutes, and Rules 25-26, 25-36, and 25-106, Florida Administrative Code.
