Docket No.020170-TP - Request by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. for approval RE: of adoption of interconnection, unbundling, resale, and collocation agreement and amendment to negotiated agreement by BellSouth and Network Telephone Corporation by DSL Internet Corporation d/b/a DSLi.

By letter dated February 27, 2002, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. filed a request for approval of adoption of interconnection, unbundling, resale, and collocation agreement and amendment to negotiated agreement entered into between BellSouth and Network Telephone Corporation which was deemed approved by the Commission on September 25, 2001. (See Docket No. 010880-TP) DSL Internet Corporation d/b/a DSLi is adopting the interconnection, unbundling, resale, and collocation agreement and amendment to negotiated agreement approved by the Commission in its entirety pursuant to Section 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.

Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(i) requires that a local exchange carrier shall make available any interconnection, service, or network element provided under an agreement approved by the state commission to any other requesting telecommunications carrier upon the same terms and conditions as those provided in the agreement in its entirety.

Staff reviewed the agreement in this Docket on May 22, 2002. The filing met the criteria outlined in Section 2.07.C.15 of the Administrative Procedures Manual in that it complies with Section 252(i) of the Act. Accordingly, with this Memorandum, the docket is hereby closed.

Allowing this agreement to go into effect should not be construed as a determination by the Commission that BellSouth has met the requirements of Section 271 of the Act.
