The approved rates should be effective for service rendered on or after the stamped approval date on the tariff sheet, pursuant to Rule 25-30.475(1), Florida Administrative Code. The appropriate wastewater rates are reflected on Schedule A of staff's July 25, 2002 memorandum.
