APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT TO CERTIFICATES OF AUTHORIZATION

HIGHLANDS RIDGE UTILITIES, LLC ("Applicant"), by and through its undersigned attorneys, and pursuant to Section 367.045(2), Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-30.036, Florida Administrative Code, files this Application for Amendment of Certificates 474-S and 544-W to extend its water and wastewater service areas, and in support thereof states:

- 3. To the best of Applicant's knowledge, the provision of water and wastewater service to this property by Applicant is consistent with the Highlands County Comprehensive Plan at the time the application is filed, as approved by the Department of Community Affairs. There is a need for service in this area immediately. The proposed territory is currently being developed by a related party and zoning approvals have been obtained. A clubhouse has been constructed and water and wastewater services will be provided to it without charge until approval by the Commission.
- 4. Attached as Exhibit "A" is a copy of the instrument confirming Applicant's right to use the property upon which its water and wastewater plants are located.
- 5. A description of the territory proposed to be served, using township, range and section references is attached hereto as Exhibit "B".
- 6. The existing wastewater treatment plant serving Highlands Ridge is permitted for an annual average daily flow of 0.095 MGD. The current average daily flows to the plant are slightly in excess of 0.040 MGD. Highlands Ridge Utilities, LLC, has submitted a permit application to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection to expand this facility to 0.20 MGD and is in receipt of a "DRAFT" permit. This plan includes a public access system for spray irrigation of the development's golf course. This expansion

work will not take place until the annual Capacity Analysis Reports indicate the additional capacity is required.

- 7. A detailed map showing township, range and section with the proposed territory plotted thereon are attached as Exhibit "C".
- 8. A map showing existing lines and facilities is included in the map attached hereto as Exhibit "D".
- 9. Attached as Exhibit "E" is a schedule of the water and wastewater permits issued to Applicant.
- 10. The permitted capacity of the existing wastewater treatment plant is 0.095 MGD. The permitted capacity of the existing water treatment plant is 0.138 MGD. There are 584 total units in Phases One through Six of the original Highlands Ridge development. There are approximately 400 existing service connections. Since the recorded flows to the wastewater treatment plant from the 400 existing connections is just over 40,000 gallons per day, the average flow per unit is approximately 100 gallons per day. The total average daily flow from the 584 units in the original development at build-out and the 217 units in Phase VII at build-out can be expected to be approximately 80,000 gallons per day.

A demand of 80,000 gallons per day equates to 55 gallons per minute. Considering a peak water system demand of four and including a fire flow of 500 gallons per minutes for residential development, yields a total demand of less than 750 gallons per

minute. In fact, there are two wells capable of pumping over 1500 gallons per minute simultaneously.

A 10 inch water main runs approximately 12,000 feet from the water plant to Phase VII. A flow of 750 gallons per minute through the 10 inch PVC water main results in a pressure drop of 0.13 feet per one hundred feet for a total loss of 15.6 psi. With a pressure at the plant of 55 psi, a line pressure of 40 psi can be expected at Phase VII during peak conditions.

- 11. Applicant has both the financial and technical ability to render reasonably sufficient, adequate and efficient service. Copies of the financial statements of Applicant are attached hereto as Exhibit "F". Attached as Exhibit "G" is a list of the Operators and their respective licenses.
- 12. The construction of the water distribution and wastewater collection systems will be financed through the existing loan arrangements with First Union Bank. There will be no material impact on the Applicant's capital structure.
- 13. The territory to be served will consist of approximately 210 single-family homes and a 5,000 square foot clubhouse.
- 14. There will be no material impact on Applicant's monthly rates or service availability charges in the short term. The addition of these new customers will allow additional economies of scale which will allow Applicant to continue to operate under its existing rate structure.

- 15. Attached as Exhibit "H" to the original Application are the original and two copies of the revised tariff sheets reflecting the additional service area. A copy of the revised tariff sheets is attached to each copy of the Application.
- 16. Exhibit "I" is an affidavit that the notice of actual application was given in accordance with Section 367.045(1)(a), Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-30.030, Florida Administrative Code, by regular mail to the following:
 - (1) the governing body of the municipality, county or counties in which the system or territory proposed to be served is located;
 - (2) the privately owned water utility that holds a certificate granted by the Public Service Commission and that is located within the county in which the utility or the territory proposed to be served is located;
 - (3) if any portion of the proposed territory is within one mile of a county boundary, the utility shall notice the privately owned utilities located in the bordering counties and holding a certificate granted by the Commission;
 - (4) the regional planning council;
 - (5) the Office of Public Counsel;

- (6) the Public Service Commission's Director of Records and Reporting;
- (7) the appropriate regional office of the Department of Environmental Protection; and
- (8) the appropriate water management district;
 Copies of the Notice and a list of entities noticed
 shall accompany the affidavit.
- 17. Late Filed Exhibit "J" will be the notice of actual application was given in accordance with Rule 25-30.030, Florida Administrative Code, by regular mail or personal delivery to each property owner in the proposed territory.
- 18. Late Filed Exhibit "K" will be an affidavit that the notice of application was published once a week in a newspaper of general circulation in the territory in accordance with Rule 25-30.030, Florida Administrative Code. A copy of the proof of publication will accompany the affidavit.
- 19. In accordance with Section 367.045(2)(c), Florida Statutes, attached hereto as Exhibit "L" is an Affidavit that Applicant has on file with the PSC a tariff and annual reports.
- 20. Applicant's last rates were set in Order No. PSC-01-1488-PAA-WS, issued July 18, 2001, in Docket No. 981147-WS(overearnings investigation).
- 21. Original Certificates 465-S has been filed in Docket No. 020695-WS and 496-W are attached.

22. The extension will serve between 201 and 500 water ERCs and between 201 and 500 wastewater ERCs so the appropriate filing fee is \$1,000, which is enclosed.




