# PUBLIC COUNSEL'S RESPONSE TO OCTOBER 3, 2002, COMPLIANCE FILING

The Citizens of the State of Florida, through the Office of Public Counsel, respond in opposition to the GridFlorida Companies' Compliance Filing dated October 3, 2002, on the following grounds:

#### PRELIMINARY STATEMENT

The Office of Public Counsel filed a notice of appeal directed to Order No. PSC-02-1199-PAA-EI with the Supreme Court of Florida on October 3, 2002. This office believes that notice effected an automatic stay pursuant to Rule 9.310(b)(2), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. Nevertheless, in an abundance of caution and to avoid any future arguments that this office may have acquiesced in the GridFlorida Companies' filing with the Commission, also on October 3, 2002, this response is offered in opposition. The fact that this response is offered to protect the Citizens' interests should not be construed as an interpretation by this office of the extent of the stay perfected under the appellate rules.

### **RESPONSE IN OPPOSITION**

1. The introductory paragraph to the GridFlorida Companies' October 3 "compliance filing" states that it is submitted for "the Commission's review of

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conformance with Order No. PSC-02-1199-PAA-EI." The last paragraph asks the Commission "to determine that this filing is in full compliance with the Order." The pleading is clearly in the nature of a petition asking the Commission for specific relief. As such, intervenors are permitted to respond in opposition to the relief requested.

- 2. Order No. 02-1199 did more than just report proposed agency actions which may have become final with the passage of time. The order also, inter alia, found that, although the rate structure had been modified in the ISO proposal, the GridFlorida Companies were still planning to transfer ratemaking jurisdiction to FERC. The latest proposal was therefore rejected based upon an explicit finding that "the modified [ISO] compliance filing does not provide for preservation of our jurisdiction over retail transmission rates and, therefore, does not comply with our December 20 order." Order No. 02-1199, at 63. The ninth ordering paragraph (at page 78) ordered that "the GridFlorida compliance filing shall be modified to recognize the Commission's continuing jurisdiction over the total cost of transmission service to retail customers." The companies have not yet submitted a rate structure proposal that leaves the Commission's ratemaking jurisdiction intact.
- 3. It was disingenuous for the companies, under the guise of complying with certain proposed agency actions, to ask for a review of their generalized "conformance" with Order No. 02-1199 and for a determination that their October 3 filing was in "full compliance" with that order.

4. The Citizens request the Commission to hold an evidentiary hearing pursuant to Section 120.569 and 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, to resolve the factual dispute whether the GridFlorida Companies' October 3 filing is in full compliance with Order No. 02-1199.

WHEREFORE, the Citizens of the State of Florida, through the Office of Public Counsel, urge the Florida Public Service Commission to hold a formal hearing and to determine that the GridFlorida Companies are not in full compliance with Order No. PSC-02-1199-PAA-EI.
