On September 11, 2002 we sent a letter indicating the minimum filing requirements (MFRs) were not met, and identified specific deficiencies. Deficiency 8 refers to Rule 25-30.440(10), Florida Administrative Code, which requires a submission of a list, by customer, of all complaints received during the test year, with an explanation of how each complaint was resolved. We have since located a notebook among the MFR filings of the customer complaints that identify the complaints by customer and an explanation of how the complaint was resolved. However, each complaint lists a subdivision and a route, such as subdivision 00618, and route 618. We are unable to identify which water or wastewater system is located in the corresponding subdivisions and routes. Please provide a key that identifies the water or wastewater system where each subdivision and route is located.

Please provide this information no later that November 9, 2002.
