### **SECTION 1 - DEFINITION OF TERMS**

The following definitions are applicable to this tariff:

Commission - The Florida Public Service Commission.

Company - Outside Connection, Inc., unless stated otherwise.

**Customer** - Any person who subscribes to or uses service under the terms and conditions of this tariff. The Customer is responsible for the payment of charges for service offered by the Company which are subscribed to or used by the Customer. The Customer is also responsible for payment of charges for a third person's use of service to which the Customer subscribes.

### **SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS**

### A. Description of Service

This tariff sets forth the terms under which the Company provides a service that gives a Customer the ability to receive collect calls from a specific station location in another exchange area from which the Customer receives numerous collect calls. The service is provided by means of automatic remote call forwarding. Customer subscribes to the service after obtaining a seven digit telephone number in the exchange area from which it receives numerous collect calls. A collect caller accesses the Customer's number by using the same dialing procedures and operator service as that caller would use in placing a collect call to any other number. All collect calls to that number are routed automatically by the Company to a station location designated by the Customer in the distant exchange area where the Customer is located. The Company's monthly invoice for service contains billing detail about each collect call received during the billing period.

### B. Service Availability

Service is available 24 hours per day, seven days per week to all those who desire to purchase service subject to the availability of the necessary facilities and consistent with all provisions of this tariff.

- 1. The Company reserves the right to discontinue service when necessitated by conditions beyond its control or when the service is used in violation of the law or this tariff.
- 2. The Company does not undertake to transmit messages and will not be liable for errors in transmission or for failure to establish connections.
- 3. Prior written permission from the Company is required before any assignment or transfer of any service arrangement provided under this tariff.

### C. Billing and Payment For Service

### 1. Timing of Calls

Usage charges for the service provided under this tariff begin when the Customer or other party at the Customer's station answers the telephone. Chargeable time ends when the connection is terminated.

### 2. Payment Arrangements

The Customer is responsible for payment of all charges for service rendered pursuant to this tariff. The Customer agrees to pay the Company or its authorized agent any and all cost(s) incurred as a result of the use of the service.

All charges due by the Customer are payable to the Company or any agent duly authorized to receive such payments. Terms of payment shall be according to the rules and regulations of the agent and subject to the rules of regulatory agencies, including the Commission. Any objections to billed charges must be promptly reported to the Company or its billing agent. Adjustments to Customers' bills shall be made to the extent that circumstances exist which reasonably indicate that such changes are appropriate.

### 4. Taxes and Fees

The Company shall charge the Customer an amount sufficient to recover any governmental taxes, assessments, fees, or other similar charges imposed upon the Company in connection with providing the service described in this tariff. Such charges shall be entered as separate line items on the Customer's bill and are not included in the charges set forth in this tariff.

### 5. Late Payment Charge

A late fee of 1.5% per month will be charged on any balance that is not either paid or disputed within 30 days of the invoice date.

### 6. Return Check Charge

A return check charge of \$20.00 will be assessed for checks returned for insufficient funds and will be assessed according to the terms and conditions of the billing entity.

### 7. Billing Disputes

- a. Billing disputes shall be processed by the Company or its billing agent consistent with Commission regulations.


