MOTION FOR SUSPENSION OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

AT&T Communications of the Southern States, LLC ("AT&T"), pursuant to Rule 28-106.204, Florida Administrative Code, hereby moves the Florida Public Service Commission for a modification of Order No. PSC-03-0635-PCO-TP to extend the time for filing direct and rebuttal testimony in this proceeding and in support states:

- 1. By Order No. PSC-03-0708-PCO-TP, the direct testimony and rebuttal testimony in this proceeding were rescheduled to allow the parties time to negotiate a settlement. The parties have worked diligently in good faith to achieve a settlement and the negotiations are substantially complete. The parties' efforts are now focused on the final last details of the settlement, which are expected to be complete within the next few days.
- 2. In light of the fact that the efforts to reach a settlement are substantially complete, AT&T hereby requests that the Commission suspend the procedural schedule to allow the final details of the settlement to be completed.
- 3. Pursuant to Rule 28-106.204(3), Florida Administrative Code, the undersigned has contacted Counsel for Supra Telecommunications and Information Systems, Inc. and Counsel for Supra has authorized the undersigned to represent that Supra agrees with the motion and joins in the motion.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth above, AT&T requests that the Commission suspend the procedural schedule in the instant case to allow for the conclusion of the settlement negotiations.
