## NOTICE OF TEMPORARY RATE INCREASE WATER MANAGEMENT SERVICES, INC.

The Florida Public Service Commission has approved Phase II of a temporary rate increase to allow Water Management Services, Inc. (Utility) to cover the cost of installing a new water transmission main to St. George Island and making certain fire flow and related improvements on the island. The new water transmission main is required because the Department of Transportation is building a new bridge to the island and will be demolishing the bridge to which the Utility's current water transmission main is attached.

The Phase II temporary rates are expected to remain in effect until approximately September 2004, at which time the Commission is expected to complete its examination of the final costs of the project and to set permanent rates to cover the Utility's cost. The Utility expects that the final rates will not differ significantly from the Phase II rates. When the final rates are set, both the Phase II temporary rates and the previously-approved Phase I temporary rates will be subject to true-up to the extent that the Utility has either over-recovered or under-recovered costs during the construction period.

The approved Phase II temporary rates, which will appear on bills rendered after the Commission has approved new tariff sheets, are as follows:
