## RE: Water Tariff - "Set Rate" Late Fee

Sunshine Utilities serves approximately 3700 connections in Marion County and almost $25 \%$ of the bills are delinquent. We have a small office, personnel wise, and spend more than one (1) full day billing delinquent accounts. Each account must be audited and delinquent notices prepared before they are mailed. This requires a lot of expense including personnel hours.

We, hereby, request that Sunshine Utilities be allowed to add a "set rate" late fee to the water tariff of $\$ 2.00$. The fee would be added to those accounts that are not paid by the due date of the water bill and is sent a delinquent notice.

In accordance with Section 367.091 (6), Florida Statutes, attached is the cost justification for the "set rate" late fee. Also, enclosed please find the Water Tariff Sheet for the same.

## MISCELLANEOUS SERVICE CHARGES

The Company may charge the following miscellaneous service charges in accordance with the terms stated herein. If both water and wastewater services are provided, only a single charge is appropriate unless circumstances beyond the control of the company requires multiple actions.

INITIAL CONNECTION - This charge would be levied for service initiation at a location where service did not exist previously.

NORMAL RECONNECTION - This charge would be levied for transfer of service to a new customer account at a previously served location or reconnection of service subsequent to a customer requested disconnection.

VIOLATION RECONNECTION - This charge would be levied prior to reconnection of an existing customer after disconnection of service for cause according to Rule 25-30.320 (2), Florida Administrative Code, including a delinquency in bill payment.

PREMISES VISTT (IN LIEU OF DISCONNECTION) - This charge would be levied when a service representative visits a premises for the purpose of disconnecting service for nompayment of a due and collectible bill and does not discontinue service because the customer pays the service representative or otherwise makes satisfactory arrangements to pay the bill.

LATE FEE - This charge would be levied when the water bill is not paid by the date due.
