ISSUE 1: Should the Commission grant the companies listed on Attachment A of staff's December 23, 2003 memorandum voluntary removal from the register and cancellation of their respective tariffs? <u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: The Commission should not grant the companies listed on Attachment A of staff's memorandum voluntary removal from the register and cancellation of their respective tariffs. Rather, the Commission should remove each company, as listed on Attachment A, from the register on its own motion with an effective date as listed on Attachment A. The collection of the past due fees should be referred to the Florida Department of Financial Services for further collection efforts. If a company's tariff is cancelled and its name removed from the register, as listed on Attachment A, in accordance with the Commission's Order from this recommendation, the respective company should be required to immediately cease and desist providing intrastate interexchange service in Florida. If any of the companies listed on Attachment A have their respective tariff cancelled and name removed from the register, and subsequently decides to reapply for registration as an intrastate interexchange telecommunications company, that company should be required to first pay any outstanding RAF, including statutory late payment charges.
