RESPONSE TO MOTION TO ENFORCE COMMISSION ORDER

ISLAND ENVIRONMENTAL UTILITY, INC. ("Utility"), by and through its undersigned counsel, pursuant to Rule 28-106.204, F.A.C., files this response to Linda Bamfield's Motion to Enforce Commission Order, and states as follows:

- 1. Ms. Linda Bamfield, an Intervenor in this proceeding, telephoned the undersigned counsel for the Utility and inquired about ompliance with Commission Order No. PSC-03-1415-PCO-SU ("Order") relating to documentation concerning the financial resources of the Utility's shareholders, including the personal financial statements of the Utility's shareholders.
- 2. Counsel for the Utility informed Ms. Bamfield that a Motion to Abate Proceeding and Revise Case Assignment Scheduling Record ("Motion") was pending before this Commission. She was advised that the Utility will file an application that would not rely on the financial resources of the shareholders of the Utility, and that the information she sought pursuant to the Order was irrelevant.
- 3. On March 25, 2004, Ms. Bamfield filed a Motion to Enforce Commission Order demanding that the Commission direct the Utility to produce the documents "immediately".
- 4. On March 30, 2004, this Commission issued Order No. PSC-04-0333-PCO-SU, granting the motions to intervene of Palm Island Estates Association, James de Wade and BER-DATE

The Preserve of Don Pedro Owners Association and the Motion. In this Order, the Commission directed that the Utility file an application that complies with Rule No. 25-30.033, F.A.C., within 60 days.

- 5. The Utility intends to file an application that complies with Rule 25-30.033, F.A.C. within the time proscribed by the Commission in its recent Order. The application will not rely on the financial resources of the shareholders of the Utility.
- 6. Ms. Bamfield's continued efforts to obtain Mr. Beckstead's financial statements, even though they are irrelevant to this proceeding, validates the Utility's arguments that Ms. Bamfield has a personal vendetta with Mr. Beckstead.
- 7. There being no reason to compel the production of the personal financial statements of the shareholders of the Utility, Ms. Bamfield's Motion to Enforce Commission Order should be denied.

WHEREFORE, ISLAND ENVIRONMENTAL UTILITY, INC. respectfully requests that the Commission deny the Motion to Enforce Commission Order of Linda Bamfield.
