C. Basic Position

Staff's positions are preliminary and based on materials filed by the parties and on discovery. The preliminary positions are offered to assist the parties in preparing for the hearing. Staff's final positions will be based upon all the evidence in the record and may differ from the preliminary positions stated herein.

D. <u>Issues of Fact, Law and Policy</u>

The following are issues identified by Staff and its positions on these issues. Staff's positions are preliminary, are based upon materials filed by the utility or obtained through discovery and are intended to inform the parties of Staff's preliminary positions. Staff's final positions will be based upon an analysis of the evidence presented at the hearing.

<u>ISSUE 1</u>: Does the Commission have exclusive jurisdiction over the certification of private utilities?

POSITION: Yes. Pursuant to Section 367.011(2), Florida Statutes, the Commission has exclusive jurisdiction over each utility with respect to its authority, service, and rates.

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<u>ISSUE 2:</u> Is the service proposed by Farmton Water Resources LLC (Farmton) exempt from Commission jurisdiction?

- **POSITION:** No position at this time.
- **<u>ISSUE 3:</u>** Has Farmton met the filing and noticing requirements pursuant to Rules 25-30.030 and 25-30.033, Florida Administrative Code?
- **POSITION:** Yes. Farmton has met the minimum filing requirements.
- **<u>ISSUE 4</u>**: Is there a need for service in Farmton's proposed service territory and, if so, when will service be required?
- **<u>POSITION</u>**: Yes. It appears that there is a need for service. However, it is not known when all forms of service will be required.
- **<u>ISSUE 5:</u>** Is Farmton's application consistent with Brevard County's or Volusia County's comprehensive plans?
- **POSITION:** No position at this time.
- **<u>ISSUE 6:</u>** Will the certification of Farmton result in the creation of a utility which will be in competition with, or duplication of, any other system?
- **POSITION:** No position at this time.
- **ISSUE 7:** Does Farmton have the financial ability to serve the requested territory?
- POSITION: Yes.
- **ISSUE 8:** Does Farmton have the technical ability to serve the requested territory?
- **POSITION:** Yes.
- **<u>ISSUE 9:</u>** Does Farmton have sufficient plant capacity to serve the requested territory?
- **POSITION:** Yes. Farmton appears to have adequate existing and proposed plant capacity to provide water service to the requested territory.

- **<u>ISSUE 10:</u>** Has Farmton provided evidence that is has continued use of the land upon which the utility treatment facilities are or will be located?
- POSITION: Yes.
- **<u>ISSUE 11:</u>** Is it in the public interest for Farmton to be granted a water certificate for the territory proposed in its application?
- **POSITION:** No position at this time.
- **<u>ISSUE 12:</u>** What is the appropriate return on equity for Farmton?
- **POSITION:** Return of equity should be based on the leverage graph formula contained in Order No. PSC-03-0707-PAA-WS, issued June 13, 2003, in Docket No. 030006-WS, In Re: Water and wastewater industry annual reestablishment of authorized range of return on common equity for water and wastewater utilities pursuant to Section 367.081(4)(f), Florida Statutes.
- **ISSUE 13:** What are the appropriate potable water, fire protection, and bulk raw water rates and charges for Farmton?
- **POSITION:** No position at this time.
- **<u>ISSUE 14:</u>** What are the appropriate service availability charges for Farmton?
- **POSITION:** No position at this time.
- **<u>ISSUE 15:</u>** What is the appropriate Allowance for Funds Used During Construction (AFUDC) rate for Farmton?
- **POSITION:** The AFUDC rate should be based on the leverage graph formula contained in Order No. PSC-03-0707-PAA-WS, issued June 13, 2003, in Docket No. 030006-WS, In Re: Water and wastewater industry annual reestablishment of authorized range of return on common equity for water and wastewater utilities pursuant to Section 367.081(4)(f), Florida Statutes.
- E. <u>Stipulated Issues</u>

There are no issues that have been stipulated at this time.

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F. <u>Pending Motions</u>

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Farmton filed a Motion to Strike Prefiled Direct Testimony on May 3, 2004.
