RESPONSE: BellSouth objects to this Interrogatory on the grounds that it is irrelevant and not likely to lead to the discovery of admissible evidence. Customers who are eligible to receive (1) services under the PreferredPack Plan and (2) the \$100 cash back, \$25 Gift Card, and the installation fee waiver promotions are residential, retail customers. Consequently, the relevant inquiry to determine BellSouth's costs in providing the residential exchange services and promotions is BellSouth's statewide 1FR average and not TELRIC.

Subject to and without waiving the foregoing objections, BellSouth does not have a TELRIC cost for residential local exchange service, for the individual features listed in the Preferred Pack Plan offering, or for the installation associated with this offering. BellSouth does have a TELRIC cost for the composite features UNE element (Element B.4.13) which was filed in Docket No. 990649-TP. That cost is

RESPONSE: The monthly cost used by BellSouth to analyze this offering is the statewide average 1FR rate of \$ plus the UNE composite feature cost of \$ . Additionally, the installation costs, which support the A4 Service Charges tariff, are . The UNE composite feature cost is based on TELRIC methodology and the installation costs are based on TSLRIC methodology. The statewide average 1FR rate was used as a surrogate cost since the actual 1FR rates are below costs. The average rate was determined by dividing the total 1FR revenues in Florida by the total 1FR lines in Florida as of April 2003. The current statewide average rate is \$ .
