Staff is preparing for our workshop on September 28-29, and we would like to structure the session to help ensure that we focus on the most important topics. To that end, we envision that each side will provide a brief overview (15 minutes) of its proposal, followed by more in-depth discussion of the key elements of its proposal (see attached tentative agenda). Each side will be given an opportunity to explain its proposal before the other side and staff provide comments and ask questions. Staff is going to make every effort to limit the time spent on any one topic, with the objectives being to identify each party's position and rationale and to determine if the point is negotiable. By the end of the workshop, based on the range of opinion and the likelihood of compromise, staff needs to determine if additional workshops or conference calls should be held or whether this matter should be set for hearing.

In reviewing the tentative agenda, please keep in mind that we are not expecting formal presentations on each of the key elements identified by staff. These topics are listed merely to indicate that staff believes these aspects are important in considering a party's proposal, and we believe additional explanation and discussion would be useful.
