## Re: Docket No. 040450-WS, Application for rate increase in Martin County by Indiantown Company, Inc.

Dear Mr. Erwin:

We have reviewed the additional explanations, schedules and data submitted by Indiantown Company, Inc. (Indiantown or utility) on October 11, 2004, to satisfy the minimum filing requirements (MFRs). However, after reviewing this information, we still find the MFRs to be deficient. The specific deficiencies are identified as follows:

- 1. Rule 25-30.440(1)(a), FAC, requires the utility to provide a detailed map showing the location and respective classification of the utility's customers. The maps submitted by the utility fail to show the location and classification of each customer.
- 2. Rule 25-30.440(5), FAC, requires the utility to submit its most recent sanitary survey for each water plant. Indiantown submitted a copy of its 1999 sanitary survey. Please provide a copy of the utility's most recent sanitary survey, which was completed in 2002.
