## I. Summary and Staff Analysis

The Hidden Valley SPE LLC d/b/a Orange Lake has applied to the Public Service Commission for a certificate to operate a water utility in Orange and Lake Counties. The proposed service area is an existing manufactured housing community to which the applicant has been providing service as an exempt system located adjacent to and east of CR 435 (See Attached Map). The utility has decided to become a regulated entity and to begin charging for water service. Orange Lake is currently built out with 244 units (242 manufactured home lots, office, and parking). There is no plan for expansion, or for the Utility to serve any additional customers. Thus, the application does not increase or decrease the service already provided by the Applicant.

The portion of the area in Lake County is designated Urban (1 du/7 ac) on the Lake County Future Land Use Map (FLUM). The surrounding land use designations are Lake County Urban. As mentioned previously, this is an existing development with an existing water and sewer system; the service area will not be increased or decreased. The application is consistent with the Lake County Comprehensive Plans.
