RE: Docket No. 041257-TL, BellSouth Telecommunication's Petition for Expedited Review of a Growth Code Denial by the Number Pooling Administrator (NeuStar) for the St. Johns exchange (Worldgolf)

On October 21, 2004, BellSouth Telecommunication submitted a code request application to NeuStar for one (1) single 1,000 block of consecutive numbers in order to meet the requests of two (2) specific customers. Also, on October 21, 2004, NeuStar denied BellSouth's application because it did not meet the utilization criteria required for a new block of numbers.

On October 27, 2004, BellSouth filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decision to deny numbering resources in the Worldgolf (STAGFLWGRS0) switch located in the St. Johns rate center. In accordance with Commission Order PSC-02-0352-PAATL (Docket No. 020087-TL) which approved an expedited process for NeuStar code denials, we have examined the BellSouth petition, along with the confidential supplemental information, and have determined the following:

1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has a customer in need of immediate numbering resources;
