3. US LEC, XO and members of SECCA are competitive local exchange companies certificated in Florida pursuant to Section 364.337, Florida Statutes, to provide competitive local exchange services. The Petitioners are competitors of BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"). US LEC and XO have existing Commission approved interconnection agreements with BellSouth.

The member of SECCA that is not seeking interconnection in this proceeding also has and existing Commission - approved interconnection agreement with BellSouth and the positions taken and relief sought by SECCA in this proceeding are of the type appropriate for a trade association acting on behalf of its members. Therefore, the substantial interests of the Petitioners are subject to determination or will be affected through this proceeding.

- 4. Disputed issues of material fact in this proceeding include, but are not limited to:
- a. Whether the Commission has jurisdiction to conduct the proceeding proposed by BellSouth;
- b. Whether the Commission's approval of BellSouth's request to approve contract amendments would violate the requirements of Section 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 ("1996 Act"); and
- c. Whether the relief sought by BellSouth in the instant proceeding would violate the terms of the agreement that BellSouth has entered into with each of the CLEC petitioners.<sup>2</sup>
- 5. Any determination and actions taken by the Commission in this docket regarding BellSouth's petition will affect the petitioners' substantial interests as CLECs in Florida.

  Accordingly, Petitioners have standing under Chapter 120, Florida Statutes and the applicable rules to participate as parties in this proceeding.

Wherefore US LEC, XO and SECCA respectfully request that the Commission grant them leave to intervene as full parties in this proceeding.
