- 1. The Order Establishing Procedure, Order No. PSC-04-1066-PCO-TL, together with the Order Modifying Procedure, Order No. PSC-04-1096-PCO-TL, required that the Prehearing Statement and the Rebuttal Testimony in this docket be filed on December 17, 2004, by 5:00 p.m.
