We are in receipt of the Notice of Application for Increase in Service Availability Charges sent to us by Hudson Utilities in regard to their proposed increase in the Service Charge. We are writing to express our opposition to the proposed increase. Because Hudson Utilities failed to complete the work in a timely manner, it is unfair to pass the increased cost on to the homeowners who will be impacted.

Our understanding is that Hudson Utilities advised the State that they could complete the work at the prior charges. When we have previously inquired, and prior to replacing our septic system, about the status of the sewer system in our area, we were always told that Hudson Utilities was waiting for the interest rates to go down so as to keep the costs down.
