Dear Director,

Hudson Utilities, Inc of 14334 Old Dixie Highway, Hudson, FL 34667 has applied to increase its service availability charges to new wastewater customers in Pasco County. The current charge is \$1,000 and they are requesting an increase to \$2,400. This is a 240% increase - absolutely ridiculous.

We have been informed that Hudson Utilities will be taking over (from Pasco County Utilities) our water and (proposed) sewage project. Sewers are to be installed in our area shortly (there have been many delays - we were told they would be done before 1/1/02), and we were under the impression that the hook-up charge would be \$1,000, which everyone agreed to. Now we are being informed that they want to increase it to \$2,400. After the sewers are installed I'm sure they will then want to increase the rates. Many citizens in our community are retired and cannot afford such a substantial increase in the service hook-up charge. As registered voters, we do not believe this increase is warranted, and request that you do not approve it.

Dear Sir or Madam:

We are in receipt of the Notice of Application for Increase in Service Availability Charges sent to us by Hudson Utilities in regard to their proposed increase in the Service Charge. We are writing to express our opposition to the proposed increase. Because Hudson Utilities failed to complete the work in a timely manner, it is unfair to pass the increased cost on to the homeowners who will be impacted.

Our understanding is that Hudson Utilities advised the State that they could complete the work at the prior charges. When we have previously inquired, and prior to replacing our septic system, about the status of the sewer system in our area, we were always told that Hudson Utilities was waiting for the interest rates to go down so as to keep the costs down. The interest rates have been falling and now Hudson Utilities wants to increase their charge. We understand that costs go up; however, to ask for more than double the original cost. While Hudson Utilities delays this project even longer the costs will continue to increase.

We believe that since Hudson Utilities told the State they could do it at the present charge, they should be held to it. We are requesting that the Florida Public Service Commission not grant the proposed increase to Hudson Utilities and would appreciate receiving a response to our letter.

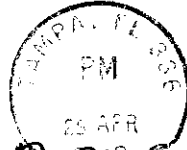
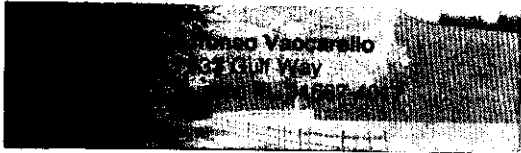


