NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a hearing will be held before the Florida Public Service Commission regarding the protest of three customers to the portion of Proposed Agency Action Order No. PSC-04-0712-PAA-WU that requires Aloha Utilities, Inc. to meet the Tampa Bay Water standard as the water leaves the treatment facilities of the utility and the methodology upon which compliance with the standard shall be determined. 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PURPOSE AND PROCEDURE

The purpose of this hearing is to consider the petition of three customers protesting portions of Proposed Agency Action Order PSC-04-0712-PAA-WU. In their petition, the three customers did not protest use of the Tampa Bay Water standard of 0.1 mg/Liter of sulfides in the finished water and the standard implementation date of February 12, 2005. However, the customers did protest the proposed requirement that the standard be met as the water leaves the treatment facilities of the utility, and also protested the methodology upon which compliance with the standard would be determined. The Commission will also consider any pending motions or other matters that may be pending at the time of the hearing, and may rule on any such motions from the bench or may take the matters under advisement.

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At the hearing, all parties shall be given the opportunity to present testimony and other evidence on the issues identified by the parties at the prehearing conference held on February 24, 2005. All witnesses shall be subject to cross-examination at the conclusion of their testimony.
