Corporate Disclosure. Sprint is a holding company organized for the purpose of engaging in telecommunications and related businesses through its

subsidiaries. Its stock is publicly traded. No person or corporate entity owns more than 10% of Sprint. In December 2004, Sprint announced an agreement to merge with Nextel Communications, Inc., subject to approval by various agencies. Sprint anticipates that the merger will close during 2005.

MOTION OF SPRINT CORPORATION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE

Sprint Corporation ("Sprint"),¹ by its attorneys, respectfully moves for leave to intervene as a matter of right in the above-captioned review proceeding pursuant to F.R.A.P. 15(d), 11th Circuit Rule 15-4 and 28 U.S.C. § 2348. Petitioner, the National Association of State Utility Consumer Advocates ("NASUCA"), seeks review of the Second Report and Order, Declaratory Ruling, and Second Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC" or "Commission") in the matter of Truth-in-Billing and Billing Format and the National Association of State Utility Consumer Advocates' Petition for Declaratory Ruling Regarding Truth-in-Billing, CC Docket Nos. 98-170 and 04-208, FCC 05-55 (rel. Mar. 18, 2005). The Declaratory Ruling denied NASUCA's request seeking to prohibit telecommunications carriers, including Sprint, from imposing any separate line item or surcharge on customers' bills that was not mandated or authorized by federal, state or local law.

Sprint moves to intervene on the side of the Respondents, the FCC and the United States of America, in support of certain findings and conclusions of law in the *Declaratory Ruling* that are under challenge.

¹ Sprint, through various subsidiaries and affiliates, is a commercial mobile radio services ("CMRS") provider, incumbent local exchange carrier, competitive local exchange carrier and interexchange carrier.

Sprint participated in the proceeding below. Sprint is directly affected by the FCC's ruling dealing with the manner in which telecommunications carriers charge their customers and will be adversely affected if the *Declaratory Ruling* "is ... enjoined, set aside, or suspended." 28 U.S.C. § 2348. Therefore, as a "party in interest in the proceeding before the agency whose interests will be affected" by this review proceeding, Sprint is entitled to intervene "as [a matter] of right." 28 U.S.C. § 2348.
