### OPC'S OPPOSITION TO ALOHA'S MOTION TO STRIKE

The Office of Public Counsel (OPC) files this response in opposition to the motion to strike filed by Aloha Utilities, Inc. (Aloha) on April 27, 2005, and states the following:

- 1. On April 27, 2005, Aloha filed a motion to strike portions of the Post-Hearing Statement filed by Petitioners Harry Hawcroft and Ed Wood. Although Aloha admits that many portions of the Post-Hearing Statement it seeks to strike contain specific references to the record, it states that the comments about the record are "in reality ... further opinion testimony regarding such exhibits" and "an attempt to introduce uncrossexamined and unsworn evidence after the close of the record." Motion to Strike at 3.
- It is perfectly proper to draw inferences and make arguments about the meaning of record evidence in a party's Post-Hearing Statement.
   Characterizing portions of the Post-Hearing Statement as "opinion testimony regarding such exhibits" does not make those portions improper. In fact,

providing argument and opinion about the meaning of record evidence is exactly what a party is supposed to do in its post-hearing statement.

3. Additionally, the Commission typically gives greater leeway to customers filings before Commission. Providing such leeway here will not change the fact that the Commission's ultimate decision in this proceeding must be based on competent, substantial evidence in the record.

WHEREFORE, OPC requests the Prehearing Officer to deny Aloha's motion to strike.
