Dear Chairman Edgar:

This letter, pursuant to Rule 25-30.430, Florida Administrative Code, requests approval of a test year for Utilities, Inc. of Florida ("Company"). The Company intends to submit an application for general rate relief to the Florida Public Service Commission for its water and wastewater systems located in Marion, Orange, Pasco, Pinellas and Seminole Counties, Florida. The Company intends to submit the minimum filing requirements ("MFRs") on or before June 30, 2006.

The Company's last general rate proceeding was in Docket No. 020071-WS, which utilized a test year ending December 31, 2001. A final order in that case was entered in Order No. PSC-03-1440-FOF-WS, dated December 22, 2003.

The Company requests a historic test year ending December 31, 2005.

The requested test year is representative of a normal full year of operation.

Since the Company's last rate proceeding, the Company has made major changes to plant and equipment, specifically, plant and equipment upgrades and modifications, safety

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and security improvements, and rehabilitative work to plant grounds and percolation ponds. Within that same period of time, there have been no major changes in operational methods.

The Company plans to make major pro forma plant additions, including but not limited to electrical improvements, coating and painting hydrotanks, rehabilitation of facilities, repairs and maintenance, and the construction of two interconnects. The MFRs will include pro forma adjustments for increases in salaries and salary-related benefits, purchased power and other costs, which will be requested in this proceeding. The proformas are non growth-related.

Pursuant to Section 367.081(8), Florida Statutes, the Company requests that the Commission process this petition for rate relief using the proposed agency action procedure. The Company also will request interim rates based on the historic test year.
