RE:	Docket No. 060284-TL - Recommendation to Office of the General Counsel - Petition for Expedited Review of Growth Code Denials by the Number Pooling Administrator for the Daytona Beach exchange (Main and Ormond Beach)

On March 8, 2006 and March 21, 2006, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth) requested additional numbering resources from the Number Pooling Administrator, (Neustar) for the Ormond Beach (DYBHFLOBDS0) and Main (DYBHFLMADS0) switches. BellSouth requested a one-thousand block of numbers to meet a customer's request for 1,000 consecutive numbers, specifically in the format (NPA) NXX – 2, 3, 6, or 8, in the Ormond Beach exchange. BellSouth requested a one (1) full NXX code of numbers to meet a customer's request for 5,000 consecutive numbers in the format of (NPA) NXX – 3-7 in the Main exchange. Also on March 8, 2006, and March 21, 2006 BellSouth's request for additional numbering resources was denied by NeuStar because it did not meet the months-to-exhaust utilization criteria required for the numbers.

CTR On March 24, 2006, BellSouth fied a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decision. In accordance with Commission Order PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL, (Docket No. 020087-TL) which approved an expedited process for the NeuStar code denials, staff has examined the BellSouth petition and has determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has customers in need of numbering resources;
- 2) The carrier has shown that it is unable to provide services to these potential customers because of NeuStar's denial of the numbering resources; and
- 3) The customers will not be able to obtain service from the provider of his/her choice because the carrier does not have the numbers available.
