Staff believes that Section 4.5.2 of BellSouth's SEEM Administrative Plan should be revised to hold BellSouth accountable for paying penalties during a force majeure event for noncompliance with retail analog performance measures. Staff's recommended revisions to BellSouth's force majeure provision is found in Attachment A to its June 8, 2006 memorandum.
