

Plantation Bay Utility Company (Plantation or utility) is a water and wastewater utility currently serving approximately 1,245 residential customers and 5 general service customers in Volusia County. On August 8, 2005, Plantation filed an application for approval of interim and permanent water and wastewater rate increases.

Plantation requested interim rates designed to generate annual water revenues of \$409,138 and wastewater revenues of \$557,994. This represents a revenue increase on an annual basis of \$62,900 (18.17%) for water and \$333,074 (148.09%) for wastewater. The utility requested final rates designed to generate annual water revenues of \$453,391 and wastewater revenues of \$628,669. This represents a revenue increase of \$107,153 (30.95%) for water and \$403,749 (179.50%) for wastewater. On October 4, 2005, the Commission suspended final rates, denied a water interim rate increase, and approved an interim rate increase of 95.19% for wastewater.

As part of the process of evaluating Plantation's final request, the PSC staff conducts a customer meeting to allow customers the opportunity to provide input into the rate setting process. Customer comments are an integral part of the process and will assist the Commission in reaching its decision. The utility's records will be audited by PSC staff for compliance with the applicable rules and orders. In addition, a PSC

staff engineer will conduct a field investigation of the utility's plant and service area. In accordance with Florida Statutes, the Commission will consider the utility's quality of service and other matters in this case.

The current rate case is being processed under the PSC's "Proposed Agency Action" (PAA) procedure. Under the PAA process, the case will not be set for a formal hearing unless a timely protest to the Commission's proposed agency action is filed.

PSC staff is scheduled to make a recommendation on the final rates to the Commission on January 19, 2006. The Commissioners are expected to vote on this matter at the January 31, 2006, Agenda Conference.

It is little wonder people in the know say get a public water system. It is a sure thing with no competition, a monopoly with a guaranteed positive return by the State of Florida, even when a poor investment is made, or a poorly managed operation occurs.

For your information, this water plant is in Flagler County and not Volusia County. Parts of the distribution system are in both counties.

In addition the water meters are read less than six times a year. If there are any big expense items in the books for salaries, they are probably a sham.

My utility bill is about \$45.00 per month (water and sewer). \$45.00 per month from 1,000 customers is a lot of revenue. It is hard to believe the current operation is not profitable, especially since the waste residue can be sold commercially as fertilizer.

I am not aware of what happens with the waste residue, but if sold it should be credited to the plant revenue. In the original development documentation it was to be used on the golf course as fertilizer. The golf club should be paying for its use, if it is so.

Please do not approve this increase.



As per the Notice of Customer Meeting document, I went to the Ormond Beach Regional Library to review the MFRs which were filed by the utility company.

First of all, the personnel at the library had difficulty finding the document, and after finding it, it was stated that no one else has requested to see it. Anyway, I was shocked to see the size of this document. It is over 3 inches thick, and practically impossible to find any information which helps understand the proposals.

How can anyone, especially a lay person, be expected to wade through this volume of information and make any sense of it?

Why can't a simple Profit and Loss statement be provided showing comparative results for the year ended 12/31/04, the Proposed Interim Rates, and the Proposed Final Rates? This should occupy a minimum number of pages

On the surface, it appears that the Proposed Final Rates for water is increasing by 19% and the Gallonage Charge is increasing by 61%. As for the Wastewater, the Class/Meter rate is proposed to increase by 167%. And the Gallonage Charge by 206%. These rates are preposterous and outlandish!

The provided documentation does not attempt to explain why the utility company would require such tremendous increases.

If you apply the Proposed Interim Rates to the 12/31/04 financial results, you would see the following:

The total revenue dollars are somewhere in between the two scenarios. It is impossible to calculate the increase on the combined charges for the Class/Meter Size and Gallonage rate without more information.

Now, instead of having a combined loss of \$35,297, the utility company is requesting rate increases which would result in a combined profit between \$360,088 and \$639,243.

Again, these profit levels are preposterous and outlandish, and are uncalled for.

In addition to the Profit & Loss statements, the utility company should present a Balance Sheet as of 12/31/04, a Pro Forma Balance sheet for the Proposed Interim Rates and a Pro Forma Balance Sheet for the Final Proposed Rates.

Are the financial statements audited by a reputable account firm?. If so, by whom? If not, why not?

According to the PROCEDURES AFTER CUSTOMER MEETINGS document, the customers have only one chance to voice their complaints and opposition to these proposed rate increases. I strongly suggest that a second meeting be set up in order to allow the Customers a second chance to be heard.

The Plantation Bay Utility Company is a small operation. Has anybody considered requesting the city of Ormond Beach to take over the operation?

I have sent the same letter to the Florida Public Service Commission.

We cannot attend the meeting on November 2nd.

Please present our objections to the commission at that meeting.

	Lastly, I would like to suggest that this small private utility company be assumed by the local municipality where economies of scale should provide more economical delivery coupled with consistent standards of our water and waste water services.

Converting the disinfection process is scheduled for October 26, 2005.

Unfortunately we are unable to attend this meeting due to medical commitments in Jacksonville but we do want our voice to be heard.

We are residents in Plantation Bay for 5½ years. We do not feel the Water Utility Company has earned the right to increase rates for three reasons:

1. The massive development and new homeowners should more than pay for itself and/or create a profit or, in our opinion, there is unqualified or poor management.

2. Floridians have been asked to conserve water and Volusia County has restricted days and times for watering yards (notice is in the Daytona News at least once a week). There are many violations in this community and it needs to be controlled - water is being wasted. We know of one family that waters 7 days a week. We don't care if they are paying the price of water or may lose their lawn to over-watering from wells, but we do care about all that water being wasted.

3. Until the "black stuff" is out of our water, there should be no increase in the cost. We have complained about this problem many times. "Nancy" sent Glenn Wetherell to us to solve the problem. He told us no others on the street had complained but when we reminded him that they told us they had the same problems his story changed. We were told to spray clorox on the faucet openings which we did every few days but the problem remained - it didn't help. At some point he decided to try flushing the water hydrants. When he returned and asked me if there was any difference I told him there was a small difference. He told us that was undoubtedly the problem and he promised he would regularly flush them . Some time later we were in contact again and we told him the condition had reverted back to it's worst stage. Again he came to the house and saw the problem. He said he would flush again on our street. When he said he had done the flushing and it should be much improved, it had not improved. He had done only one flushing. He then promised to flush the hydrant in our area every week, which we can see from our window and can see it flood the street. The every week turned out to be just once. These flushings helped a bit and after having had two or three in that period of time there was an improvement but the every week ended with the one flushing and we haven't heard from Mr. Wetherall for over a year now. I don't see anyone flushing the system. Eventually we were totally ignored - however, the problem still exists. We also contacted St. John's Water who told us they would come and test the water but noone ever showed up. We lived in Jupiter, Florida for 5 years and in Palm Coast for 9 years and never had





We are writing in response to the proposed increases for wastewater treatment on behalf of those of us who use public water for irrigating our yards.

Our gallons of water use are higher than those of our neighbors who use wells for watering their yards, but, a substantial portion of our water is not returned through the wastewater treatment system. Your proposed increase for wastewater treatment penalizes us for sprinkler use and assumes a greater percentage of wastewater than is actually treated.

For instance, we are a two person household and are snowbirds. The only water use we have during the summer is for lawn care. We used an average of 9600 gallons for the months of June – October 2005, at an average rate of \$66.74 for the 5 months. None of this water was returned through the wastewater treatment system but we were charged as though a portion had been.

We propose that there should be an allowance for those who use water for sprinkler systems and do not send that water back through the wastewater treatment system.

Thank you for your consideration of this matter.



Dear Director:

We received a notice of an interim rate increase for residents who use the Plantation Bay Utility Company. The interim rate increase of nearly 100% is appalling, and the possibility of an even higher increase being approved by your Commission is totally unacceptable. We strongly urge you to reconsider the current increase and not allow any additional increases at this time.

As you know, the water quality provided by Plantation Bay Utility required attention, as it did not meet State and Federal requirements. The company had not even done what they should be doing to keep the water quality within guidelines. We know they have worked the problem, but during that time, we used bottled water, per their suggestion. That cost us money while we continued to pay their full fees. We are already paying more than a fair price for their services. In addition, they "round" water use instead of using precise readings when determining monthly costs.

Residents in this community are mostly retired or semi-retired and moved to Florida with a planned, fixed income. Increases like the one you have granted, let alone the one you may approve, are not budget friendly for the very category of residents who help make Florida the great state it is. For example, folks like us pay towards public schools but never use them, pay for state maintained roads and have private roads in the community (which we must pay separately to pave), and so forth. With all the increases we have had to endure this year, such as increases from our homeowners insurance company, the Florida Power and Light, telephone company and cell phone company, it is reaching a point where living in Florida means paying more than one's fair share.

Please be thoughtful of the residents who live in Plantation Bay, consider the track record of the utility company, and --

Reduce the excessive 100% interim rate you have already approved and Do not allow any further increases for at least a full year.



Proposed changes would up Ormond water, sewage bills

By EILEEN ZAFFIRO STAFF WRITER

ORMOND BEACH — Those who use the city's water and sewer service could see their bills grow by 20 percent to 30 percent start-

ing early next year.

The increases that top city staff members are recommending mean that households using up to 2,000 gallons of water a month could be looking at an increase of \$3.82 in their total monthly bill. People at the highest end of the spectrum, those who use 20,000 gallons per month, would see a hike of \$31.52 each month.

Those outside the city who get Ormond Beach residential water and sewer service would face monthly bill increases ranging

from \$5.71 to \$47.39.

A West Palm Beach company that came up with those numbers in a rate study said three more smaller fee hikes might also be necessary beginning in October 2006, October 2007 and October 2008.

But before anyone's bill grows, the idea has to get the blessing of at least three city commissioners. And, for now, commissioners say they want to hear more before they make any decisions.

Commissioners aren't slated to take their first formal vote until their Dec. 20 meeting, which will delay staff members' original goal for the new rates to take effect Jan. 1. The new target date to start higher rates is Feb. 1.

If commissioners decide to leave water and sewer rates as they are now, the current budget would have to be cut by \$1.9 million to make up for the money the hikes would have generated, said city Finance Director Paul Lane

Several things within water and sewer operations are spurring the call for higher rates: plans to expand the city's water treatment plant, an extra \$321,000 for salaries and benefits, \$290,000 for debt payments, \$283,000 to cover electricity cost increases and \$700,000 to cover a reduction in last year's budget.

"It's a painful thing to do, but it may be the right thing to do for the city," said City Commissioner Troy Kent. "I'm struggling

with it."

Most commissioners appeared to be uncomfortable with the size of the suggested hikes. "I think it's excessive," said

Commissioner Jeff Boyle.

"I, personally, feel the costs are astronomical," Commissioner Ed Kelley said. "We need to start by looking at what's driving the increase."

- 1. It appears to me that their request is inordinately high. After looking at the financial statements for 2003 and 2004, it appears that there are miles of gravity and force main sewers, lift stations and pumping equipment being installed for future development, which costs should not have been charged to Plantation Bay Utility Company, but paid for by the developer.
- 2. As of November 29, 2005, the Secretary of State's Office still lists Francois Lazare and Steven Irwin as Officers/Directors of Plantation Bay Utility Company. However, these individuals are not listed as Officers/Directors on Page 13 of 84 for the years 2003 and 2004.
- 3. There was a substantial change of 77.5% in ownership in Plantation Bay Utility Company from Francois Lazare to Morteza Hosseini-Kargar. (Please see Business Transactions with Related Parties on Pages 15 and 16 of 84 for the year 2004.) Was this transaction

The Commission is expected to consider this Recommendation at its February 7, 2006, Agenda Conference which will be held in Room 148, Betty Easley Conference Center, in Tallahassee beginning at 9:30 a.m. If you wish to attend, please arrive promptly at the beginning of the Agenda Conference, as we cannot state the exact time at which this item will be heard. You are welcome to come to this Agenda Conference and observe and/or participate in the discussion of this item. You may also watch at our website http://www.floridapsc.com.

As stated in our telephone discussion on the afternoon of January 11, 2006, the responses to the comments and questions contained in your previous letter received December 8, 2005, are as follows. First, you commented that the gravity and force sewer mains, lift stations, and pumping equipment are for future development and should be paid by the developer. Prior to the 2001 year end, the utility was authorized to accept donated property from the developer. However, in Plantation's 2001 earnings investigation, the Commission ordered the utility to discontinue the collection of donated property because of Plantation's unique circumstance at that time. That unique circumstance was discussed on pages 17 to 19 of Order No. PSC-02-1449-PAA-WS, which I had sent you via e-mail on January 11, 2006. As discussed on pages 77 to 79 of the enclosed recommendation, staff is recommending that the utility should be allowed to collect donated property beginning January 1, 2007.

Second, you stated that the Secretary of State's Office still lists Francois Lazare and Steve Irwin as officers/directors of the utility, but Plantation's 2003 and 2004 annual reports filed with the Commission do not reflect these individuals as officers/directors. As I stated in our telephone discussion, I have relayed your concern to the Commission's certification section as well as the attorney assigned, which is processing the utility's application for transfer of majority organizational control in Docket No. 050912-WS.

Third, you asked whether the change in ownership from Francois Lazare to Morteza Hosseini-Karger was the result of a purchase, sale or transfer of securities, non-cash transfer of assets, new cash dividends other than stock dividends, or a write-off of bad debt or loans. According to the utility's transfer application filed in Docket No. 050912-WS, the shares were transferred pursuant to a stock purchase agreement, which was financed by cash from the buyer. As discussed on page 80 of the enclosed recommendation, staff does not believe that the apparent violation of Section 367.071, F.S., rises to the level of warranting the initiation of a show cause proceeding against Plantation Bay in these circumstances for failure to obtain approval prior to transferring majority organizational control of the utility. The utility filed an application for approval of the transfer shortly after being advised of the requirement by staff.

In your letter dated January 23, 2006, you also commented that, during our telephone discussion, you noted that the developer appeared to use numerous names. Again, I do not know the reason why on some documents the developer's name appears as "Morteza Hosseini-Karger" versus "Morteza Hosseini". I have also relayed this concern to the Commission's certification section as well as the attorney assigned, which is processing the utility's application for transfer of majority organizational control in Docket No. 050912-WS.

Finally, you requested to know what has happened in this matter since I spoke with you by telephone. The utility filed its application for transfer of majority organizational control on December 12, 2005. Along with the application, the utility filed an Emergency Petition requesting variance or waiver of certain rule requirements pertaining to transfer applications. However, on January 17, 2006, the utility withdrew the Emergency Petition and the utility must comply with all of the requirements of the Commission rules governing applications for transfer of majority organizational control. The transfer application is in the process of being analyzed by the certification staff.
