Petition for Expedited Review of Growth Code Denials by the Number Pooling

Administrator for the Orlando exchange (Azalea Park).

On October 16, 2006, BellSouth requested additional numbering resources from NeuStar for the Azalea Park (ORLDFLAPDS0) switch. BellSouth requested additional numbers to meet a customer's request for 100 consecutive numbers, specifically in the format NPA NXX-56XX. On October 16, 2006, BellSouth's request for additional numbering resources was denied because it did not meet the months-toexhaust utilization criteria required for additional numbering resources.

On October 18, 2006, BellSouth filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decision. In accordance with Commission Order PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL, (Docket No. 020087-TL) which approved an expedited process for the NeuStar code denials, staff has examined the BellSouth petition and has determined the following:

- 1. The carrier has demonstrated that it has a customer in need of numbering resources;
- 2. The carrier has shown that it is unable to provide services to this potential customer because of NeuStar's denial of the numbering resources;
