## **PROPOSED JANUARY 2007 DATA NOTIFICATION**

BellSouth is considering making the changes described in this document to generate results for the January 2007 data month. Results for the January 2007 data month will be posted as follows:

Preliminary results	February 20, 2007
Final results	February 28, 2007

BellSouth provides Data Notifications each month in compliance with the SQM Plan. This order specifies that when BellSouth proposes making any changes to the methods by which performance data is calculated, it must provide written notice. This notice must be provided on the first business day of the month before the data month in which the change will be made. BellSouth must also provide notification if it is considering making changes to the method of calculating data for the following month.

ENCORE Releases may affect monthly data flows from the source systems (e.g., LEO, LESOG, etc.) that PMAP uses to calculate measurements. BellSouth will make changes to PMAP to ensure that data continues to be correctly captured as ENCORE Releases are implemented.

### **Ordering Measurements**

- (1) *Affected Measures:* O-9 (FOCT) NC Only

*Description of Change:* Currently, the Resale Design product is on the 12-month FOCT report in North Carolina, but not on the Aggregate FOCT report. BellSouth proposes to modify the code to display the data on the Aggregate report correctly. This proposed change was Item (1) on the Preliminary January 2007 Data Notification filed on November 1, 2006. (RQ8458)

*Impact of Change:* None. Due to the impact of this change, reposting is not necessary.

### **Provisioning Measurements**

- (2) *Affected Measures:* P-7C (CPT)

*Description of Change:* Currently in PMAP, orders with the same circuit identification are being double counted. BellSouth proposes to modify the code to identify these orders correctly. This proposed change was Item (2) on the Preliminary January 2007 Data Notification filed on November 1, 2006. (RQ8686)

*Impact of Change:* For December 2005 through June 2006, only 1 record in GA was identified with this condition. Due to the impact of this change, reposting is not necessary.

(3) *Affected Measures:* P-2B (PJ) NC Only

*Description of Change:* Currently in PMAP, BellSouth is incorrectly identifying the retail analog for some orders for the UNE Analog Loop Design disaggregation. BellSouth is using the Retail Residence and Business (Design) product group as opposed to the correct product group of Retail Residence, Business and Design (Dispatch) (Excluding Digital Loops). BellSouth proposes to modify the code to place these orders into the correct disaggregation. This proposed change was Item (3) on the Preliminary January 2007 Data Notification filed on November 1, 2006. (RQ8719)

*Impact of Change:* For August 2006 data, the Retail metric would decrease by .18 to 00.91%. Due to the impact of this change, reposting is not necessary.

(4) *Affected Measures:* P-1 (HOI), P-3 (MIA), P-4 (OCI), P-5 (CNI) All States, P-2A (PJ48), P-2B (PJ), P-9 (PPT) All States except LA, & P-2, P-7 (LA only)

Currently, BellSouth.Net ADSL Services that are ordered by a CLEC through the LNP Gateway are being assigned a CLEC Company ID. These orders should be reported in the product group 'ADSL provided retail.' BellSouth Proposes to modify the code to identify these orders correctly. This proposed change was Item (4) on the Preliminary January 2007 Data Notification filed on November 1, 2006. (RQ8764)

*Impact of Change:* For July 2006 data, one (1) record in Florida was assigned an inappropriate Company Key. Due to the impact of this change, re-posting is not necessary.

For July 2006 data, there were no records that were assigned an inappropriate Company Key in Georgia. Due to the impact of this change, re-posting is not necessary.

### **M&R Measurements**

(5) *Affected Measures:* M&R-2

*Description of Change:* Currently PMAP is incorrectly identifying the company for some lines in service identified as BellSouth "UNE." BellSouth proposes to modify the code to identify these records correctly. This proposed change was Item (5) on the Preliminary January 2007 Data Notification filed on November 1, 2006. (RQ8763)

*Impact of Change:* For August 2006 data, there was no change in the metric for Georgia or Florida. Due to the impact of this change, re-posting is not necessary.

## Special Access Measurements

- (6) *Affected Measures:* SA-3 (OVRD)

*Description of Change:* Currently, the PMAP report is displaying a duplicate row of data for the DS1 product buckets. BellSouth proposes to eliminate the duplicate row and report only one numerator, volume, and metric. This proposed change was Item (6) on the Preliminary January 2007 Data Notification filed on November 1, 2006. (RQ6086)

*Impact of Change:* None. Due to the impact of this change, re-posting is not necessary.

- (7) *Affected Measures:* SA-4, SA-5, SA-6, SA-7, & SA-8

*Description of Change:* Currently, BellSouth is not including orders that have subsequent due dates that differ from the original due date located on the initial ASR. This situation exists when the associated missed appointment code is Null, SP (Subscriber Prior), or SL (Subscriber Later). BellSouth proposes to modify the code to report these orders correctly. This proposed change was Item (8) on the Preliminary January 2007 Data Notification filed on November 1, 2006. (RQ8728)

*Impact of Change:* For August 2006 data, the CLEC metric for Past Due Circuits due to IXC reasons in Florida changed from 8.82% to 100% for the DS1 and disaggregation. Due to the impact of this change, re-posting is not necessary.

For August 2006 data, the CLEC metric for Past Due Circuits due to IXC reasons in Georgia changed from 7.14% to 44.44% for the DSO disaggregation and from 6.33% to 36.99% for the DS1 disaggregation. Due to the impact of this change, reposting is not necessary.

- (8) *Affected Measures:* SA-7 AL & GA

*Description of Change:* Currently, the 12-month report for the Past Due Circuits measure is displaying a BSLD Numerator value at times when the BSLD Volume value is zero. BellSouth proposes to modify the code to eliminate this problem. This proposed change was Item (9) on the Preliminary January 2007 Data Notification filed on November 1, 2006. (RQ8733)

*Impact of Change:* None. Due to the impact of this change, re-posting is not necessary.

- (9) *Affected Measures:* SA-1

*Description of Change:* Currently, the 12-month report is not including the data for the benchmark of “>= 98% within 2 or 5 business days” for some products. BellSouth proposes to modify the code to report these orders correctly. This proposed change was Item (10) on the Preliminary January 2007 Data Notification filed on November 1, 2006. (RQ8781)

*Impact of Change:* None. Due to the impact of this change, re-posting is not necessary.
