CITIZENS' MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE REBUTTAL TESTIMONY

The Citizens of the State of Florida, through the Office of Public Counsel, request an extension of two weeks, from February 20, 2007 until and including March 6, 2007, within which to submit rebuttal testimony in the above docket, and in support state:

- 1. This docket was initiated by a petition that Citizens filed on August 10, 2006.
- Citizens filed direct testimony of expert witness Robert Sansom and OPC employee Patricia Merchant supporting their Petition on October 19, 2006.
- 3. By agreement of parties, and as memorialized in Order No. PSC-07-0048-PCO-EI, the dates for the filing of Progress Energy Florida Inc.'s (PEF) testimony and Citizens' rebuttal testimony were established to be January 16, 2007, and February 20, 2007, respectively.
- 4. Progress Energy Florida Inc. filed its testimony and exhibits on January 16, 2007.

 PEF filed testimony of thirteen witnesses, many of whom sponsor numerous exhibits. Because of the sheer number of witnesses whose testimony Citizens need to evaluate, as well as the need to conduct discovery related to the testimony, Citizens require an extension of time to prepare their rebuttal properly.

- 5. An extension of two weeks, until and including March 6, 2007, will provide

 Citizens a more adequate opportunity to prepare rebuttal testimony. The existing schedule can accommodate the extension without prejudicing any party.
- 6. Citizens' counsel has discussed this request with counsel for Progress Energy

 Florida Inc., and is authorized to represent that PEF does not object to the granting

 of the two week extension.

Accordingly, Citizens request the Prehearing Officer to enter an order granting this Motion, and extending the deadline for the filing of rebuttal testimony until and including March 6, 2007.
