As shown below, AT&T has reduced its rates by more than the required flow through amounts attributable to the Embarq, Verizon and BellSouth access reduction tariff filings.


State Cost Recovery Charge (In-State Connection Fee)

A monthly service charge that is applied to Customers subscribed to AT&T for long distance services associated with a residential telephone line or billed to a residential account. This charge reflects costs incurred by AT&T of providing instate long distance service over AT&T's Customers' local exchange providers' networks. This monthly charge is applied if a customer has AT&T billable charges on their bill, including, but not limited to, monthly recurring charges or

minimum usage charges. This charge does not contribute towards any applicable minimum monthly charge. Customers in AT&T's Lifeline program are exempt from this service charge.

* The In-State Connection Fee rate was reduced from \$1.25 to \$0.00 effective July 1, 2006.
