I am writing to acknowledge receipt of the Town of Gulf Stream's resolution supporting the conversion of overhead electric distribution facilities to underground facilities and encouraging the Florida Public Service Commission to implement all reasonable measures to encourage the conversion of electric distribution facilities to underground facilities.
