On February 9, 2007, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida (AT&T Florida) filed its <u>Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification</u> pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), for certain information contained in **FPSC Document No. 01382-07**: AT&T Florida's response to Staff's First Data Request, Item Nos. 1, 5 and 7.

On March 1, 2007, AT&T Florida filed its <u>Request For Specified Confidential</u> <u>Classification</u> pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, F.A.C. and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, for certain information contained in FPSC Document No. 01382-07. Attached to its request, AT&T Florida submitted another copy of the documents previously identified as FPSC Document No. 01382-07: the second copy was identified as **FPSC Document No. 01943-07**.

AT&T Florida claims the information in Document Nos. 01382-07 and 01943-07 for which confidential classification is requested contains confidential business information related to competitive interests utilized by AT&T Florida to conduct its business and has not been disclosed to the public. AT&T Florida claims that public disclosure of this information would cause harm to AT&T Florida. The information subject to the request for confidential classification relates to AT&T Florida's estimated costs for the installation of network facilities in two private subdivisions, and AT&T Florida's net present value cash flow analysis for the potential revenues generated from those two private subdivisions.

Upon review of the information contained in the document, technical staff concurs with AT&T Florida that the identified information meets the requirements for confidential classification pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006(5), F.A.C., and as such, the information should be treated as confidential.
