MR. FLETCHER: Commissioners, Bart Fletcher with Commission staff. Staff has two oral modifications to its recommendation. First on Page 11 in the recommendation paragraph of Issue 4 --

CHAIRMAN EDGAR: Okay. Hold on. Let us get there.
Okay.

MR. FLETCHER: On Line 3 starting with, "Aqua's attestation that," the following words "it does not have any outstanding" should be stricken and replaced with "the amount of Aqua." And then on the fourth line of that same sentence the words "is capped at 40 million" should be added.

And for consistency a similar change should be, also be made in the staff analysis section. These changes do not affect staff's recommendation to approve a corporate undertaking by Aqua America, Inc., to guarantee any potential refund of revenues collected under interim conditions.

Second, staff would like to note that for informational purposes the rates listed on the rate schedules 4A and 4B of the various systems under the column "Utility Requested Final" are incorrect. The rates represent the standalone rates. However, the utility is proposing countywide uniform rates. Staff will revise the schedules for the order,
