On June 13, 2007, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida (AT&T Florida) filed its Request For Specified Confidential Classification pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, F.A.C. and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, for certain information contained in **FPSC Document No. 05238-07**: AT&T Florida's Responses to Nocatee's First Request for Production of Documents requesting any and all documents and responses produced to staff.

The documents for which AT&T Florida is requesting confidential classification are the
same documents included in AT&T Florida's responses to Staff's First Data Request, Item Nos.
1, 5 and 7, filed on February 9, 2007, and filed again on March 1, 2007. The confidentiality of
these documents was previously addressed in a memo dated March 7, 2007 (copy attached).
AT&T Florida claims the information in Document No. 05238-07 for which confidential
classification is requested contains confidential business information related to competitive interests utilized by AT&T Florida to conduct its business and has not been disclosed to the
public. AT&T Florida claims that public disclosure of this information would cause harm to
AT&T Florida. The information subject to the request for confidential classification relates to AT&T Florida's estimated costs for the installation of network facilities in two private
