Dear Mr. Friedman:

In order to further review the application, O&S Water Company, Inc. will need to provide the following:

- 1. The number of late payments for the past 12 months. (you can use the same period as the information we received on consumption)
- 2. The amount of total bad debt expense for the past twelve months.
- 3. A justification, or explanation, of why the amount of deposit should be based on a 2-month period versus a 1-month billing period.
- 4. What amount of deposit will the current customers be charged if a new or additional deposit is required pursuant to Rule 25-30.311(7), Florida Administrative Code? Will it be the \$73 or a two-month average based on that individual's actual bills over the most recent 12-month DOCUMENT NUMBER-DATE period?
- 5. Explain in detail the billing process from the meter reading, initial bill, to the delinquent notice, to the actual disconnection of the service including estimated timeframe for each.
