AMENDED PETITION FOR WAIVER OF PORTIONS OF RULE 25-6.043, FLORIDA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE

COMES NOW Florida Public Utilities Company ("FPUC"), and amends its Petition for Waiver of portions of Rule 25-6.043(1), Florida Administrative Code and as basis would show:

3. On June 13, 2007, FPUC filed a Petition for Waiver with the Florida Public Service Commission pursuant to Section 120.542, Florida Statutes, and Rule 28-104.002, Florida Administrative Code. In that Petition, FPUC sought a waiver of portions of Rule 25-6.043, Florida Administrative Code, <u>Investor-Owned Electric Utility Minimum Filing Requirements</u> ("MFRs"). The FPSC requires utilities subject to their regulation to submit MFRs with petitions for rate relief. The schedules contain detailed accounting, engineering, rate, cost of capital and similar data which is used by the FPSC as part of its review and analysis of the requested relief.

4. FPUC had requested a waiver/variance from several of the schedules in an effort

to facilitate the preparation and review of the schedules and to reduce some of the expense

involved with preparing the schedules. With this Amendment FPUC would withdraw the

requested waivers/variances except as to Schedules C-37 through C-41.

Schedules C-37 through C-41 are "benchmark" related schedules providing a

comparison of actual expenses to a calculated expense which has been expanded by the CPI for a

period of years. FPUC would provide this information but requests a variance of the schedules

to require that the schedules be presented through the historic year 2006 rather than through the

projected 2008 test year. The projected test year is based upon 2006 which will be actual data,

thus easier to analyze when applying the CPI factors. The projection methods and assumptions

related to the projected test year will be detailed in the schedules and available for review.

Providing the benchmark schedules through the 2006 historic period will reduce administrative

costs of preparing the schedules and the Commission will still have the necessary data and

information to use in analyzing and comparing actual and calculated results.

For the reasons given, FPUC would request that the Commission approve the Amended

Petition and grant the waiver/variance of the referenced MFR schedules.
