Dear Mr. Walden:

I am writing to provide you with the information requested in your September 13, 2007 letter regarding water service to the undeveloped area in the northern end of the Golden Hills subdivision. Please note that the Utility has responded to the wastewater service issues raised in your letter by amending its application to delete the request for an expansion of the wastewater service territory.

The undeveloped lots are in an area of a subdivision the remainder of which is being served by Utilities, Inc. of Florida and there will be a need for service in the reasonable foreseeable future for these additional lots. There are no other utilities to provide this service to these lots.

Any future development activity in Golden Hills that includes water service to the undeveloped lots at the north end of the system will be done after execution of a standard developer agreement. Utilities, Inc. of Florida routinely requires the execution of a developer's agreement deeding the facilities to Utilities, Inc. of Florida prior to the provision of service. Therefore, there would not be any impact to the current customers.
