AT&T Florida's Request for Confidential Classification of Document No. 08866-07 in Docket No. 050863-TP: Complaint by dPi Teleconnect, L.L.C., against BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida for dispute arising under interconnection agreement.

On September 28, 2007, AT&T Florida filed its request pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, for confidential classification and treatment of the information contained in FPSC Document Number 08943-07, which is AT&T Florida's Response to dPi's Request for Information, No. 1-19. AT&T claims that the information contained in this response should be classified as proprietary, confidential business information pursuant to Section 364.183(3)(e), and Section 364.24, Florida Statutes, and exempt from public disclosure requirements of Section 119.07, Florida Statutes.

AT&T Florida states that the information contained in the above response includes dPi customer-specific information that is confidential and proprietary. Specifically, this information consists of telephone numbers of dPi's end users; public disclosure of such information would be in contravention of the above referenced statutory provisions, and would result in the public disclosure of private information regarding subscribers. AT&T Florida has treated, and intends to continue to treat, the information for which confidential classification is sought as private, and this information has not be generally disclosed.
