Dear Mr. Melson:

We are in the process of reviewing the Commission's responses to our public records request as well as other public records related to Doris Moss. As we have done so, several items have come to light that we believe warrant further investigation and review by the Commission:

- It appears that Ms. Moss was making strange inquires with the FCCU "dba Anna Christie" (see attached email) in late 2004 and early 2005 and wanted to open an account for some purpose using a fictitious name - presumably Anna Christie. Ms. Moss inquired about the need to imprint an address on the checks related to that account. At that same time, Ms. Moss registered the fictitious name "Anna Christie" with the Florida Department of State (see attached registrations) using a P.O. Box as her address. We believe the Inspector General should investigate what funds went into that account and from whom they came.
- It appears that all the fictitious named businesses with which Ms. Moss was involved (Anna Christie and D.L. Property Management) were not reported on her financial disclosure forms filed with the Commission on Ethics. We believe the Inspector General should investigate why all appropriate financial disclosures were not made.
- It appears Ms. Moss remained on unpaid leave from BellSouth while she was on the staff of the Commission. We believe the Inspector General should investigate why a BellSouth employee was simultaneously on Commission staff.

- In December 2005, there is email correspondence among Meredith Mays, Mike Harper, and BellSouth "Security" attempting, it appears, to determine the identity of "Anna Christie." (This information was included in the package of materials distributed to the parties for the first time on February 13, 2006). We would ask that you subpoen a from BellSouth all documents evidencing BellSouth's attempt to determine the identity of "Anna Christie." Covad, and presumably the Inspector General, were able to trace the pseudonyms used by Ms. Moss in her improper emails in a matter of days. Why BellSouth could not do the same in a matter of months requires explanation.
- Finally, the list of questions sent to the Commissioners and Staff from Anita Megna was contained in a document that would have had to be opened in order to view it. We request that you (or your designee) open the document, click "File", click "Properties" and provide us with the creation date and all other information that is revealed. We would also request all Ms. Moss' emails on this "creation" date. Obviously, the origin of that document must be determined.

While Covad continues its investigation, it is of the view that further investigation into Ms. Moss' activities while a Commission employee is necessary to determine the full extent of any motivations, bias or influence she may have exerted while at the Commission. As always, thank you for your cooperation.
