The pre-filed supplemental direct testimony of Thomas Cornell should be kept. Staff recommends that the highlighted information should be considered confidential within the meaning of Section 366.093(3) (d) and (e) because it contains or constitutes contractual information, such as pricing or cost estimates, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of PEF to contract for goods and services on favorable terms. Upon a finding by the Commission that the highlighted information is proprietary confidential business information, the information should not be declassified for a period of at least 18 months and should be returned to PEF as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business.

Exh. No. TC-9 [engineering, procurement and construction contract for pollution control projects being constructed at Crystal River Plant Units 4 and 5, as part of the clean air regulatory program approved in Order PSC-05-0998-PAA-EI] should be returned to the company. Staff no longer needs this information.

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
