2	COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Good afternoon, everyone,	
3	and I'm glad everybody is here. I think we're all here and I	
4	think we're ready to go. So let's call the hearing to order,	
5	and if staff would please read the notice.	
6	MS. BRUBAKER: Good afternoon, Commissioner.	
7	Pursuant to notice, this time and place has been scheduled for	
8	the purpose of conducting a Prehearing Conference in Docket	
9	070602-EI. The purpose of the Prehearing Conference is set	
10	forth more fully in the notice.	
11	COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Thank you. Okay. Let's	
12	just go ahead and take appearances, since we're so jammed here	
13	this morning or this afternoon.	
14	MR. ANDERSON: Good afternoon, Commissioner.	
15	COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Good afternoon.	
16	MR. ANDERSON: My name is Bryan, B-R-Y-A-N, Anderson.	
17	I'd like to also enter the appearances of my colleagues:	
18	R. Wade, W-A-D-E, Litchfield, Mitch Ross and Jessica A. Cano,	
19	C-A-N-O. Our address is 700 Universe Boulevard, Juno Beach,	
20	Florida, on behalf of Florida Power & Light Company.	
21	COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Thank you and welcome.	
22	MR. ANDERSON: Thank you.	
23	COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Are there any preliminary	
24	matters we need to address before we get to the draft	
25	Prehearing Order?	

MS. BRUBAKER: Staff is not aware of any at this 1 time. 2 COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Anything from the parties? 3 MR. ANDERSON: No, Commissioner. 4 COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Okay. Let's go through the 5 draft Prehearing Order now. And I'll identify the sections and 6 7 I want, I want you to holler up, give a yo, a hey, a hand wave or anything. If you -- if there are any corrections or 8 9 changes, please just catch my attention because we'll try to go through this guickly and we'll start now. 10 So Section I on case background. 11 MR. ANDERSON: None from FPL. 12 MS. BRUBAKER: None for staff. 13 COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Okay. Section II, conduct 14 of proceedings. 15 MR. ANDERSON: Looks fine. 16 17 MS. BRUBAKER: No change. COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Okay. No change. 18 Section III, jurisdiction. 19 MR. ANDERSON: No change. 20 21 MS. BRUBAKER: No change. COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: IV, procedure for handling 22 confidential information. 23 24 MR. ANDERSON: No change. 25 MS. BRUBAKER: No change.

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1	COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Okay. V, prefiled		
2	testimony and exhibits, witnesses.		
3	MR. ANDERSON: No change.		
4	COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: No change. We're just		
5	moving right along here.		
6	Section VI, order of witnesses.		
7	MS. BRUBAKER: I would note with regard to the order		
8	of witnesses that, and this will also come up in conversation		
9	with other sections of the prehearing, draft Prehearing Order,		
10	it looks as though proposed stipulations will be proposed for		
11	each of the issues that have been identified in this		
12	proceeding. Pursuant to that, staff has polled all the		
13	Commissioners' offices to see whether FPL's witnesses, who are		
14	at this time the only witnesses to the proceeding, whether		
15	those witnesses could be excused. All Commissioner offices		
16	have responded to staff, to me that those witnesses can be		
17	excused, so I would ask simply that the Prehearing Order be		
18	allowed to reflect that.		
19	COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Absolutely. Duly noted and		
20	done.		
21	And Section VIII, basic positions.		
22	MR. ANDERSON: No change.		
23	MS. BRUBAKER: No change.		
24	COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: No change. Okay. I'm		
25	sorry. Did I say Section VIII? That was Section VII.		
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MS. BRUBAKER: Beg pardon? 1 COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: I'm sorry. 2 MS. BRUBAKER: I'm sorry. Am I leaping ahead? Are 3 we on Section VIII? 4 COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: No. I jumped ahead. 5 We are on Section VII, basic positions, and I believe there were 6 7 no changes. MS. BRUBAKER: No changes to VII. 8 COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Okay. Now we're at Section 9 VIII, issues and positions. 10 MS. BRUBAKER: Thank you. I would note gain that 11 we're exploring proposed stipulations to all issues. I do note 12 that with regard to Issue 9 there continues to be a little 13 discussion about the wording of that issue. I'm very confident 14 that in the next day or two and certainly by week's end we will 15 be able to iron out the remaining language for that proposed 16 stipulation. But with that, I think the proposed stipulations 17 will be as reflected currently, with the possible exception of 18 Issue 9. 19 COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Okay. Are we okay? All 20 right. And hopefully we'll continue the discussions on that. 21 And we'll move to Section IX, exhibit list. 22 MS. BRUBAKER: If I could again, I'd simply note that 23 pursuant to procedures we've been utilizing in hearings, staff 24 will prepare a comprehensive exhibit list. It will list all 25

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1	the prefiled exhibits and number them for ease of reference at	
2	the hearing.	
3	Staff is exploring also whether to prepare a	
4	composite exhibit list reflecting entry, proposed entry into	
5	the record of discovery responses. We have not yet made a	
6	final determination whether we will propose that or not. If we	
7	do, we will prepare that list and provide it to FPL in advance	
8	for its review.	
9	COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Okay. And, Mr. Anderson,	
10	that's okay?	
11	MR. ANDERSON: That's just fine with FPL. We're very	
12	appreciative of staff's consideration and review.	
13	COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Great. Thank you.	
14	Okay. Section X, proposed stipulations.	
15	MS. BRUBAKER: Okay. Just once again for the record,	
16	it appears that we will be able to propose stipulation on all	
17	issues, so it's reflected thusly in that section.	
18	COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Wonderful.	
19	Okay. Section XI, pending motions.	
20	MS. BRUBAKER: Staff is aware of none.	
21	MR. ANDERSON: None on behalf of FPL.	
22	COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: None on behalf okay.	
23	Very good. Section XII, pending confidentiality matters.	
24	MS. BRUBAKER: Currently there are no pending	
25	confidentiality matters.

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COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Okay. It looks like we're 1 moving to Section XIII, posthearing procedures. 2 MS. BRUBAKER: Staff has no changes for that section. 3 Okay. Section XIV, COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: 4 rulings. 5 MS. BRUBAKER: With the rulings section, especially 6 when it does appear that we're moving forward for a full-blown 7 evidentiary proceeding, often the Prehearing Officer may wish 8 to make a ruling that opening statements, if any, should not 9 exceed five minutes. Again, we may or may not be in that 10 posture since it appears this may be a stipulated matter. Ι 11 suppose it would be appropriate to ask FPL whether they have 12 any preferences in that regard. 13 COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Absolutely. Mr. Anderson? 14 MR. ANDERSON: We really don't have a preference in 15 that regard. You know, we plan to follow staff's lead in 16 finalizing this matter on Monday. We think this is a very 17 significant and important improvement for our customers that's 18 being made. We'll probably reflect that at the time of the 19 things going into the record preferably and hopefully in 20 advance of a bench ruling, but we really wish to follow staff's 21 lead as to how they want to go. 22 My suggestion, I suppose, in order to MS. BRUBAKER: 23 afford maximum flexibility on this issue is simply to reflect 24

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25 || that opening statements, if any, should not exceed five

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1	minutes. I'd be happy to reflect it if it's your desire to do
2	so.
3	COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: That sounds great. Good to
4	go.
5	Okay. Any other matters to address in this docket?
6	MS. BRUBAKER: I'm not aware of any, Commissioner.
7	As I say, staff and FPL will continue to hold discussions
8	regarding the wording of a proposed stipulation for Issue 9.
9	Unless there are any additional changes to the Prehearing
lÒ	Order, I think we're good to go.
11	I would ask if FPL is aware of any typographical
12	errors or anything like that, please let me know as quickly as
13	possible.
14	MR. ANDERSON: We'll do another close review, but
15	thus far the paperwork has been in very good order and there
16	have been no exceptions to report. Thank you.
17	COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: That's great to hear. And
18	hearing no other matters, we adjourn. Thank you.
