(b) Complaint. Each complaint, in addition to the requirements of paragraph(a) above shall also contain:

1. The rule, order, or statute that has been violated;
Violation of Rule/Order/Statute 25-6.105(5)

2. The actions that constitute the violation:

Actions: cutting off the electricity without any notice
Loss of business, loss of food, loss of medicines.

3. The name and address of the person against whom the complaint is lodged:

Florida Power and Light Corporation
A Florida Utility Company

4. The specific relief requested, including any penalty sought:

Immediate restoration of the power.

Immediate replacement of the computers, refrigerator, coffee maker (Gevalia), microwave damaged by the sudden surge due to the without warning to shut down the power to the above named items. Florida power and light had replaced two of the items and paid for the evaluation of the damage to the computers on one previous occasion.
